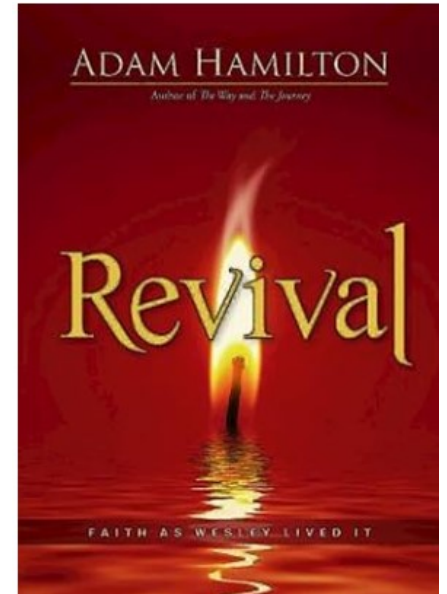


Wonder Wednesday

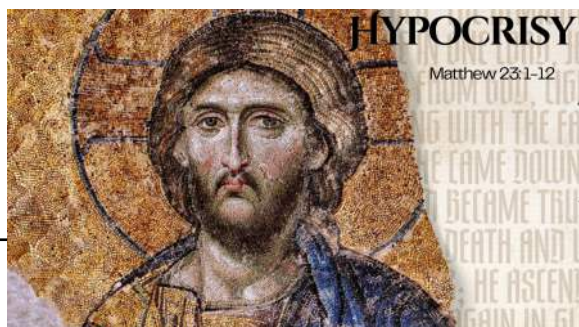
